

A Few Pigs Left

The boys and girls have taken hold of the pig contest in fine shape. Quite a number of the pigs are already in their pens and the pens are available for the boys and girls to put their pigs in. There's a pig when there is a chance to make \$100 on it by next summer. Here is what you can do to get it on:

The Porkerman Pig Contest

It's a contest for the boy or girl who can sell the pig. The plan is this: Porkerman Herd of Berkshires—Ten weeks old pigs \$25; 12 weeks old pigs \$30; 14 weeks old pigs \$35; 16 weeks old pigs \$40. Then they will be brought to Barrington and judged. The best pig will be brought back to the Porkerman Herd of Berkshires for another 10 weeks. The best pig will be sold at auction for \$100 or more. The others will be sold at auction to the highest bidder. Any boy or girl can enter their own pig if they can keep it, and anyone may bid higher than the original price if they wish.

Suppose, for example, that your pig was judged to be the very best. You can keep it for another 10 weeks. When you sell it, the Porkerman Herd will place a \$100 on the pig. Then if some one else wants to bid higher than that, your pig will bring more money.

Just think of buying a pig for \$25 and selling her in seven or eight months for \$125! That is a pretty easy way to make \$100, isn't it? But pure bred pigs make money fast!

Rules of the Contest

1. Pigs may be bought by any boy or girl under 18 years of age.
2. You may enter your pig if you think that you live in the country.
3. Those who buy best will have the right to sell the pigs.
4. If there is any dispute as to who will have any one pig, the master will be settled by drawing lots.

Contest ends at 12 noon on Friday after Dec. 1.

6. Those who buy pigs will be given a free trip to the International Livestock Exposition at Chicago on Tuesday, Dec. 3. All the transportation, room and board will be paid for. Books, pens, and suitable guides will be supplied so that the boys and girls may have an opportunity to learn about pure bred live stock.

7. The pigs will be sold at auction at once. Use the application blank at the bottom of this page.

The pigs are to be brought to Barrington next summer—the exact date to be determined by the Porkerman Herd.

8. All pigs to be sold at public auction and all of the money brought by the pigs is to go to the boy or girl who raised them.

10. Any boy or girl may buy the pig.

11. Any one may bid on the pigs, but the Porkerman Herd of Berkshires will be the highest bidder. The second best will be the second best for not less than \$100, and the third best for not less than \$75. To make good this guarantee, the Porkerman Herd of Berkshires will pay the difference between the price of the best and the price of the second best.

12. Any boy or girl may buy as many pigs in the contest as they wish, but all pigs to compete must be purchased from the Porkerman Herd of Berkshires at \$25 for ten weeks old pigs and \$40 for seven months old pigs.

13. The pigs may be paid for in either of the following ways:

a—Cash with application. b—By depositing the value of the pig in War Savings Stamps and sending the application to the Porkerman Herd of Berkshires. You will pay for the pig in cash.

c—By depositing the value of the pig in Liberty Bonds.
