When Texas landed from Mexico and delivered itself a free and independent nation in September, 1835, it was living the famous lone star flag. This flag bore two horizontal stripes, one red and the other white, with a blue field in the center which was a white five-pointed star, emblem of the American people, who fought against the tyranny of the Mexican government for freedom.

The lone star flag waved over the Alamo when Davy Crockett made his sensational stand against the armies of Santa Anna near San Antonio on March 6, 1836. After the falling of the Alamo, the lone star flag was the only flag that remained in the region.
