Bond Issue Suit May Result in Final Settlement

The decision of the village board and the previous village board for nearly two years, not including the criminal procedure in which the village was involved. Early last summer Attorney Maloney advised the trustees to file suit against the bondholders, the paving engineering firm, the surety company involved, etc., in order to bring all interested parties into one suit in circuit court.

Final Settlement

He advised that the decision of the court probably would settle all civil liabilities in the case. The board did not act on this proposal. Now that the village treasurer has been named a defendant in a suit brought by one or more of the bondholders, Mr. Maloney believes that the opportunity exists for bringing all other interested parties into the case as co-defendants. If this can be done, a final settlement of the entire case probably will follow.

Jewel Tea Co. Annual Sales Report Shows Two Year Comparison

The Jewel Tea Co., Inc. reports sales for the four weeks ending December 31, 1932, of \$847,961.17 as compared with \$801,006.40 for the four comparable calendar weeks ending December 28, 1931, a decrease of 14.52 per cent. The five weeks of the thirteenth period 1931 were \$1,200,012.53.		
Sales for the fifty-two weeks 1932 were \$11,048,550.65 as compared to \$13,484,190.34 for the same weeks in 1931, a decrease of 18.06 per cent. Sales for the fifty-three weeks 1931 were \$13,000,215.27.		
The fiscal year 1931 included fifty-three weeks, the extra week being taken up every five or six years to keep the company's fiscal year in practical agreement with the calendar year.
