Route 59 May Be on \$750,000 Road Building Program The fate of highway 59 through Barrington is still uncertain, principally because of political changes in the highway department. According to information received in Barrington the district office at Elgin has been shaken up. Herbert G. N. Lamb, district superintendent, will continue with the work in Barrington and other counties known.

There is reason to believe that the proposed improvement may be carried out this spring regardless of present conditions in the district and state offices. A field day announcement from Barrington is stating highway construction program to cost more than \$3,750,000 in public works and buildings has been realized. Most of the contracts have been awarded and call for an expenditure of more than \$3,000,000 for domestic highways and more than \$750,000 in areas outside the Chicago metropolitan area. More than 175 miles will be paved in the domestic, together with grading, resurfacing, bridges and grade separations.
