C. Ryner's Guests and Daughter Hurt in Auto Accident
Adelle Ryner, 14-year-old local girl, and seven other persons were injured and two auto... destroyed in a collision at the intersection of Higgins and... Barrington roads about 10 p. m. Saturday. Two ambulances called following the accident rushed the occupants of both cars to the... hospital at Elgin. The driver, James Ryner and his two granddaughters, Miss Lotta Fletcher, 19 years old, all of Camanche, Ia., who had motored to Barrington for a visit with Mr. and Mrs. C. T. Ryner, 214 W. Main street, and living Chambers, 39, and Henry Steiner, 35, both of Des Plaines, occupants of the other car...

The guests of the Ryners had visited A Century of Progress Friday, making Adelle Ryner with them, and were returning from the fair when the accident occurred. Examination at the hospital revealed the following injuries: Mr. Fletcher: small bone in one hip broken; Mrs. Fletcher, broken pelvis; Miss Lotta Fletcher, fractured pelvis and sprained knee; Adelle Ryner, severe cuts around shoulders and back; Mr. Ryner and Miss Mary Fletcher, cuts and bruises; Mr. Chambers, compound fracture of right arm; Mr. Steiner, scalp laceration and bruises. All were suffering from shock. A piece of glass 2 1/2 inches long was removed from the middle of Adelle Ryner's back when the wounds were dressed. It was reported, and it was necessary to take 13 stitches in Miss Mary Fletcher's back. Miss Fletcher's injuries were able to be brought to the Ryner home in Barrington and are being cared for there.
