## Arlington Beats Palatine 32 to 0 for League Lead

Arlington Heights practically clinched the conference grid championship by defeating a fighting Palatine eleven 32 to 0 last Saturday on the Cardinal field.

A strong chilly northwest wind made playing conditions bad but failed to hinder the powerful Cardinal running attack which put over two touchdowns in the first five minutes of play.

Winning the toss and taking the wind advantage, the Cardinals clinched the game in the first quarter. Long runs enabled Hines and Reubling to cross the Palatine goal in the first minutes of play.

Mierhoff scored the third touchdown in the second quarter on a 56 yard run through the right side of the Palatine line. The score at the half was 28 to 0.

Arlington put on a sustained march of 60 yards for their fourth score in the third period with Hines going over for the score. Late in the last quarter when both Grose and Nagel had in second team players in the lineup, Arlington scored for the fifth time. Deane recovered a fumble, Michaels ran for 25 yards and Johnson scored the touchdowns.
