

# Salem Nips St. Paul 22 to 19 in Overtime Thriller

## Two Grabenkorts Make Three Points to Bring Victory

### Methodists Nose Out St. Anne, 24 to 22; Remain in Third Place

Salem nosed out St. Paul 22 to 19 for first place honors in an overtime period after a fast and thrilling game Wednesday night. The Grabenkort brothers scored three points between them to turn the tide for Salem in the overtime period. The Methodists defeated St. Anne 24 to 22 in a close game to remain in third place.

At the end of the quarter, St. Paul was leading seven to two and at the end of the half was still leading nine to four. During the last half the Salem men drew ahead, however, and were leading 19 to 16 with about two minutes to play. A free throw by Kahman and an under the basket shot by Wolf tied the score at 19 all and made an overtime necessary.

Wayne Grabenkort then sank a field goal while his brother Bill sank a charity toss to give Salem a 22 to 19 victory.

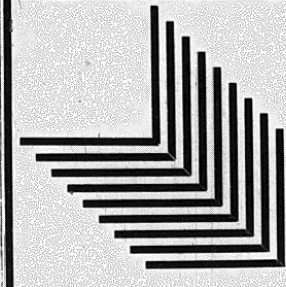
