### Bank Will Pay Cash Dividend

Checks in Mail Late This Week, Receiver Reports

**R.F.C. Dividend for First State is Expected in Three Weeks**  
A five per cent cash payment amounting to nearly \$1,000,000 will be made to depositors of the First State Bank of Barrington this week with checks being placed in the mail Friday or Saturday. The payment is from cash collections and will not interfere with the RFC which will go through with two or three weeks, according to H. E. Robertson, deputy receiver.

The payment this week will make the total to nearly \$1,000,000 to depositors since the bank closed in January, 1932. The dividend early in May from an RFC loan probably will be for 15 per cent although the exact amount will not be known until the loan is received from the government corporation.

That loan has been approved the collateral, including real estate mortgages, bond accounts, etc., has been accepted, but some required steps such as checking title to property, paying taxes, etc., have not been completed.

When the RFC loan is made, a total of nearly \$45,000 will be released to the community.

### Judgment Transcript Against Stockholders Is Entered in Court

Transcript of Judgment for \$103,304.04 against 124 stockholders of the First State Bank of Barrington was entered in circuit court last week.

According to the report only 12 stockholders have satisfied the judgment against them.

6. To stimulate a desire in the hearts of parents to become scout leaders and to have their boys become scouts.  
7. Organization of a boys' press club, consisting of an older boy from each troop, as a scout reporter, working under the district chairman to cover special troop activities of his troop for local newspapers.
