3 Per Cent Sales Tax Will Go Into Effect on Monday

New Scale of Charging Will Be Adopted; Tokens Available

The three cent sales tax to replace the present two cent tax on retail to the consumer, merchants must pay to the state 3 per cent of the gross amount of all such sales. Because of the difficulty in taxing small amounts (for example 3 per cent of 10 cents is a fraction of a cent) the following bracket of graduation has been adopted by merchants in several large cities:

Warnings Issued to Water Patrons With Delinquent Accounts

Village water department patrons who are delinquent in their bills are receiving notices that they must liquidate their old debts on a weekly basis while at the same time paying their quarterly bills promptly.

The large majority of patrons pay their bills promptly and take advantage of the available discount, Village Clerk A. C. Burandt reported. Most of those who have delinquent balances have made arrangements to pay small amounts weekly and do not violate their agreements, he said.

A few patrons have failed to make their payments. Their water service will be discontinued with an additional charge for turning on the meters when the bills are paid, it was reported.

Hoheim Will Sue for Commission on Tax Collections

Law Hender Faces Action on Two Percent Allowed Local Collectors

Verne Hoheim, Cuba town tax collector, has given notice that he will file suit against Law Hender, Lake county clerk, for commissions due him as local tax collector. History of the case dates back to last December when Hender refused to turn over tax books to Hoheim.

According to law and previous methods of procedure, Mr. Hoheim contends, he should have had the books in his possession from April 1 to June 1. According to his claim he should receive 2 per cent of all taxes collected during that time.

Last year only three town collectors had access to the books. They were the Cuba, Elia and Vernon collectors. The year all taxes were collected through the office county treasurer.

Mr. Hoheim was elected to the office of collector and, therefore, feels he is entitled to act in that capacity, he said.

His suit, he states, will ask for 2 per cent of all taxes collected at the treasurer's office during the period from April to June.

Speaker at Arlington Declares G.O.P. Job Is Defeat of Socialism

"We believe that the maintenance of the independent sovereignty of the federal government and the severing of the ties which bind the constitution to the maintenance of our American system of government," Jacob D.
