Captain Cook, Explorer, Was Slain by Hawaiians

Capt. James Cook, English naval captain and explorer, was born on October 28, 1728, at Cleveland in Yorkshire.

In 1768 he was sent to the Pacific with an expedition to observe the transit of Venus. Having observed the transit from Tahiti, he voyaged westward, completing the first circumnavigation of New Zealand, charting the coast. Passing on to Australia, he surveyed the east coast northwards and sailed through the Strait separating it from New Guinea, showing that these two lands were not connected.

The following year (1772) Cook received command of an expedition which was sent out to determine the extent of the reported southern continent. Sailing again to the south and east, in January, 1774, Cook's second voyage covered more than 20,000 leagues, and was the first circumnavigation of the globe eastward. Upon his return he was made a member of the Royal society and received the Copley medal.
