

Leyden Track Team Defeats Bronchos Here Thursday, 70 to 57

Norman Nestlerode Ties Dash Record; Triangular Friday

Eagles Win Opening Meet of Season by Taking Nine Firsts

Nine firsts helped the Leyden Eagles to claim a 70 to 57 victory over the Barrington Bronchos in a dual track meet at North side park last Thursday. The feature event of the meet was the 100 yard dash in which Norm Nestlerode broke the tape and tied the school record of 10.5 seconds set by Bennie Drover in 1932. Other first place winners for the locals were Saul in the high jump, Church in the javelin, and Kampert in the low hurdles. The Barrington Frosh-Soph won the Frosh-Soph 440 yard relay, being clocked at 53.8 seconds.

The Bronks are scheduled to meet Grant and Libertyville in a triangular meet at North Park Friday.
