

"Wells Fargo" Is Week-End Bill at Catlow Theatre

"Submarine D-1" Now Show- ing; "She Married an Artist" Here Saturday

The situation, played for comedy, offers many novel twists which climax when each finds out the other's identity.

INTO THE KETTLE

With Valentine parties a perennial favorite, Barrington hostesses may appreciate two of Mrs. E. Schott's favorite recipes in harmony with a red and white color scheme.

Both concoctions are as pretty as they are delicious.

BLACK CHERRY SALAD
2 pkgs. cherry jelly.
4 cups hot water.
When jelly begins to set, add 1 No. 2 can black cherries.
1 jar stuffed olives (med. size).
1/4 cup blanched almonds.
Serve with swoops of salad dressing made by using equal parts of boiled dressing and whipped cream. Baking powder biscuits, cut in heart shapes are an appropriate supplement.

PECAN TORTE
1 cup butter.
1 1/2 cups powdered sugar.
3 cups hot water.
3 separated eggs.
1/4 lb. chopped pecans.
1/2 doz. large lady fingers
2 doz. almond macaroons.
Cream butter. Add sugar. Add whole eggs one at a time and 3 egg yolks. Add nuts. Fold in whites, beaten stiff. Line tub or mold with lady fingers. Add thin layers of butter mixture alternately with macaroons. For last layer, add lady fingers. Keep in refrigerator 12 hours. Turn out on cake plate and cover with whipped cream. Garnish with fresh strawberries or red candy hearts.

Purpose of Rifling Firearm
The rifling grooves pass from chamber to muzzle in a spiral direction, which gives a rotating motion to the bullet which continues after it has left the barrel. The bullet during its flight "goes to sleep" like a boy's top that is well spun, which causes it to fly accurately point first for a much greater distance than it would if shot from a smooth-bore barrel.
