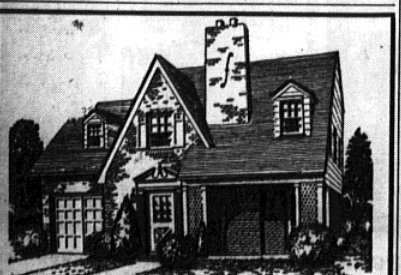

Discuss Budget for Recreation Program
A meeting of the commission appointed to plan organization of a community recreation program was held at the public school Tuesday evening. At that time a discussion of an estimated budget was held.

It was reported that approximately \$1000 would be needed to handle the project. The budget was divided into four sections, with the school board, village board, countryside group and participating organizations being placed in separate sections. They each are to be responsible for the raising of \$250.

The recreation program as outlined would require the services of two supervisors.

Making Cinder Walk
The village street department, under the direction of Paul Parcell, superintendent, is constructing a cinder sidewalk on the west side of Hough street from the E. J. & E. railroad crossing to a point north of the First creek bridge. Cinders are being furnished by the railroad, and, according

to Trustee Rudolph Berg, chairman of the street committee, the state highway department has agreed to make a suspension pedestrian walk along the west side of the bridge over the creek.
