Dealers Cooperate in National Home Laundry Week

Plan Displays of Washers, Ironers and Other Equipment

The advantages of new equipment are being stressed in "National Home Laundry Week" which starts next Monday and is being promoted by manufacturers of washers, ironers, water heaters, and other devices used in doing the family washing.

A device whose message appears on this page are retailers of various machines who are cooperating in this community in heralding the virtues of modern laundering.

The typical, old-fashioned "bit of dirt" is being hauled from her last stronghold, the American home. Washington home economics authorities report, and it is such devices as the household washer that have hastened her disappearance. 
'Sensation' of 1893 Home Becomes Relic Alongside 1939 Washers


