

\$1500 Increase In Included in Annual Village Tax Levy

Total Is \$23,285 In Spite of Reductions Ordered in Tentative Budget

An increase of \$1500 in the annual tax levy was voted in the ordinance adopted by the village board Monday night despite a proposed reduction of \$1400 in the tentative budget earlier last week. The ordinance was approved following a motion made by William A. P. Kocher Jr., and seconded by Trustee John H. Bell. The total for next year is \$23,285, compared to \$21,785 in 1932.

The increase was caused by a larger tax appropriation for the bonds and interest contracts. The total increase from 1931 to 1934 is \$12,000. The increase in 1934 is \$1,500. The schedule was up to date regarding outstanding bonds.

The village board is now asking the maximum in tax 11 per cent, and based on present tax collections, such an increase is estimated.


