A NEEDED IMPROVEMENT

Members of the village board, after having been confronted for several years with the serious problem of improving our local water supply by removing the noxious odor of sulphur, are availing eagerly to hear public reaction to the new aerator that is being operated this week.

We were privileged to watch the aerator being put through its first big test Saturday morning. Water pumped from the village's two wells is sent gushing over three coke-lined trays, where it is saturated with air. After passing through the aerator, the water enters the main reservoir before being sent into local homes.

As we stood near the aerator, we were appressed with a total cost of approximately \$1100, the odor of sulphur as it was being freed from the water was highly noticeable.

Possibly the new improvement won't achieve all that the village heads expect, but judging from the performance we witnessed Saturday morning, it will go a long way to furnish us with the proper, healthy kind of water we want.

We will be several weeks before the aerated water will have an opportunity to complete the circulation of the village water mains and a change in the water is not expected before that time.

We sincerely hope the aerator works. Something surely needed to be done. If the results come close to approximating local water users' wishes, a community's thanks, we are certain, will be offered to members of the village board.
