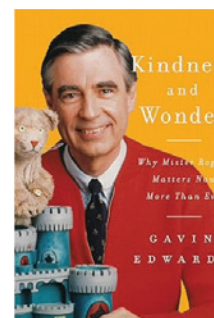

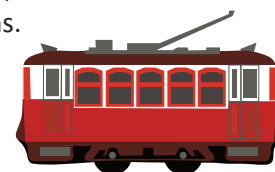
**Gavin Edwards on

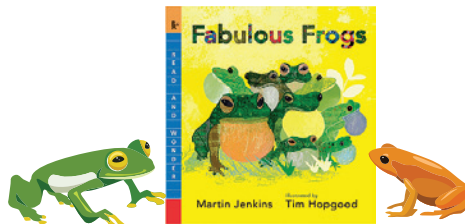

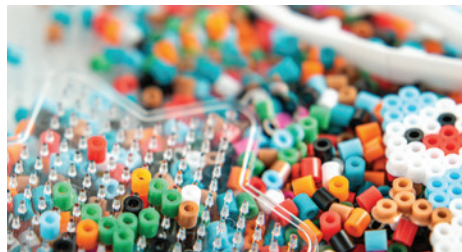
