## REGULATIONS

WITH WHICH SUBSCRIBERS HAVE AGREED TO COMPLY.

**A LOCAL MESSAGE** is a communication of five minutes or less duration between subscribers' stations within the same Exchange limits.

**A TOLL MESSAGE** is a communication between subscribers' stations in different Exchange limits, but within the area in which the Company operates.

**USE AND CARE OF EQUIPMENT.**—The subscriber shall not make, permit or use any electrical or mechanical connection, or apparatus with the lines, or equipment furnished by the Company without the Company's consent. The lines and equipment on subscriber's premises shall be carefully protected and used where installed, and upon any termination of subscriber's contract shall be surrendered to the Company, unimpaired except by reasonably careful use. At all reasonable times the Company shall have the right, which subscriber shall provide, of access from the street line, and of entering the premises of the subscriber to install, inspect or repair the lines or equipment, or to remove them upon the termination of the subscriber's right of use. The lines or equipment furnished shall not be used for receiving, transmitting or delivering any message in respect of which a consideration has been or is to be paid to any person other than the Company, except as may be permitted by the Company. The subscriber shall not use or permit the use of foul, abusive or profane language, or persons any other individual with fraudulent intent, over the equipment furnished. The telephones are the property of The American Bell Telephone Company, are constructed and used under its patents, and are leased and loaned by it to the Company only for uses permitted under contracts with subscribers.

**THE COMPANY DOES NOT GUARANTEE UNINTERRUPTED WORKING OF THE LINES OR EQUIPMENT. RISKS OF SERVICE ARE ASSUMED BY THE SUBSCRIBER,** except that for any complete failure of service of which notice in writing has been sent to its General Manager, and continued for more than twenty-four hours thereafter, an adjustment of the contract charges for the period of such interruption shall be made. The Company shall not be liable for defaults occurring on any other line, and the subscriber agrees to reimburse the Company for all sums it may pay or become liable to pay for messages transmitted for the subscriber over other lines than its own.

**SUBSCRIBER'S NUMBER.**—The prefix and number assigned to a subscriber's station are no part of the contract with the Company, and may be changed by the Company when necessary. The Company assumes no liability for errors, omissions or changes in its directories relating to a subscriber's station or number.

**COLLECTIONS** from coin boxes will be made about once a month, or oftener if necessary. **THE SUBSCRIBER EXPRESSLY AGREES TO MAKE SETTLEMENT AND PAY DEFICIENCY, IF ANY, WHEN THE COLLECTOR CALLS.** In Nickel Service a five-cent piece, in accordance with instructions on the instrument, shall be dropped into the slot each time a local call is made, and will be retained by the Company if the subscriber is put into communication with any one at the telephone station called for. Upon local calls from a Dime Station no charge will be made if no communication is had with the particular person asked for. All other coins or tokens found in the box shall be redeemed by the subscriber at the rate for the service for which they were used.

**CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR LOCATION.**—The Company will move the equipment to any point, where the Company furnishes similar service, within the limits of the same Exchange system accessible with its facilities upon written order when the subscriber agrees to pay the Company's current charges therefor. Such removal will be made without charge after the equipment has remained in the location for one year, but such removal without charge will constitute an express extension of the subscriber's contract for a period of one year from the completion date of the removal. After a removal, the subscriber shall pay the current rate for service at the location to which the removal is made.

**TERMINATION.**—The subscriber or the Company may terminate the contract on terms stated therein at any time before the contract has been in use one year at one address or location and may terminate after said year by giving ten days' written notice, in which case the subscriber shall pay in full to the end of such ten days, and the Company will refund the portion of any payment made in advance unearned at the end of such ten days.

## GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS TO TELEPHONE USERS

**TELEPHONE NUMBERS:** Each subscriber's telephone is designated by a number placed to the left of his name. In calling for subscribers, it is necessary that the number be given.

**HOW TO USE THE TELEPHONE:** To call the Exchange office, take the hand telephone from the hook and place at the ear or give two quick turns of the crank. Take down the telephone immediately, and listen for the operator. The operator will say "Number Please," Give Exchange name and number of the subscriber wanted and the operator will repeat them to avoid mistakes. Remain with the telephone at the ear until an answer is received. If the desired line is busy, the "Ring" signal (an interrupted, buzzing noise), or the operator, will notify you of that fact. This means that the line called for is connected with some other line. Always ring off when through with your telephone. Always hang up your receiver when through talking.

**NICKEL SERVICE:** To call the Exchange, proceed as above and deposit a nickel in the slot in accordance with instructions on the instrument.

**HOW TO ANSWER A TELEPHONE CALL:** Remove the hand telephone from the hook and give your own number, as for example, "This is Main 284" (or whatever the number may be). This will immediately inform the person calling that the desired connection has been established.

**REPORT TROUBLE:** When line or instruments are out of order, notify the Manager or Chief Operator of the nearest Exchange. If trouble is not remedied within 24 hours, kindly send notice in writing to A. S. Hibbard, General Manager, 203 Washington Street, Chicago, Illinois. Claims for rebates on account of interruptions to service cannot be considered unless such written notice has been given to the Company.

**TOLL MESSAGE,** deposit and rates shall be as now or hereafter established by the Company. In calling for toll connections, proceed the same as in making a local call, i. e., call by Exchange name and number for the station listed in this directory. Toll service is authorized only for patrons personally corroborating. The Company's employees must not undertake to transmit or deliver verbal or written messages for patrons.

**A LONG DISTANCE MESSAGE** is a communication from the subscriber's station to any person located beyond the limits of the area in Illinois and Indiana within which the Company operates. The duration of the rates for Long Distance Messages shall be as now or hereafter established by the Companies rendering the service. Subscribers having copper metallic circuits with long distance instruments can talk direct from their telephone to any of the points reached by the Long Distance Company, such as New York, Boston, Philadelphia, etc. In making a call to any of these points, ask for "Long Distance." When the operator answers "Long Distance," give the name of the town, the name and address or the necessary information to identify the party desired.

On account of interferences by currents of electric railways, light and other electric systems, it is not possible to insure satisfactory communication by subscribers having grounded exchange lines. The character of the service in such cases will depend largely upon local interference encountered. Subscribers having this class of service are recommended to use the nearest public telephone station equipped with metallic circuit and long distance instruments.

Long Distance messages can be sent collect, providing the person receiving a collect message agrees to allow same to be charged to him.

In making a call to any of the points reached by the Long Distance Company, if it is desired that a particular person be reached, such person must be specifically called for. If he is not found, and if no communication is had over the lines, no charge will be made. If the telephone number only is called for, and communication is established with it, the regular charge will be made.

**DIRECTORY:** Local Directories will be issued as often as the number of sections, changes and additions warrants same. Always use the current issue to obtain correct numbers.

The Company assumes no liability for damages arising from errors or omissions in the making up or printing of the directory. Subscribers are requested when they desire any change made in their insertion to notify the Company in writing.

## FARMER LINES.

### Special Notice to Rural Party Line Subscribers.

The rural or "farmer lines" of the Chicago Telephone Company, are built and maintained in the best possible manner for the purpose of giving **CONTINUOUS** good service. The stations served by such lines are necessarily grouped together, several on a line, in order to bring the cost per station down to a practical and attractive figure; the cost of a private line being usually prohibitive owing to the length of line required.

If, then, several of you **MUST** use your telephone line in common, the service you get will depend upon how you use it and upon how the telephone company handles its part. Co-operation and suitable regulations are necessary for each. We have rules to govern our Managers and Operators and ask you to aid us, in giving good service, by letting us know whenever you think we are not doing our part. We, however, are not in a position to directly enforce the rules which you should follow, but we submit them herewith, for your consideration and with the hope that you will see the necessity of following them and, as far as you can, of seeing that your neighbors follow them.

If your neighbor "hogs" the road and makes you take the ditch, you don't blame the highway commissioners, who furnish and maintain the road; you try to settle it with your neighbor, don't you? Well, it's a good deal the same with a farmer telephone line, or any other convenience which you have to share with others. "The greatest good for the greatest number" must be the rule, and the ones directly interested must be the ones to enforce it.

### PARTY LINE RULES.

1. Never ring on the line or attempt to use the line until you are **SURE** that no one else is using it or until, having waited a reasonable time, you are **SURE** that some one is monopolizing it. (See 4 below.)

2. Never answer any but your own ring number.

3. Answer promptly, but not until the bell stops ringing.

4. Limit your conversation to **five minutes or less** and always give up the line as soon as possible after another party indicates a wish to use it.

Operators are **AUTHORIZED TO DISCONNECT AT THE END OF FIVE MINUTES** if other customers are waiting for the line. The Company reserves the right, and will help in every way it can, to enforce this rule and thus prevent the monopolizing of the service by any one subscriber.

5. In emergencies, such as fire, sickness, robbery, etc., any one using the line should at once give it up to the one wanting it; and the latter should, of course, be excused for thus interrupting a conversation.

6. Never leave the telephone off the hook when through with the line, as this may stop all service on that line.

7. Never listen on the line when others are using it.

8. Do not allow non-subscribers to use the service. If you do, you are giving away something that does not belong to you. The time that you don't need on the circuit belongs to the other subscribers on the line. The use of a farmer line station by two families, instead of one at each station, doubles the number of calls which hurts the service of all and puts a needless load on your line.

9. Make complaints to the Chief Operator or Manager rather than to the operator. Make complaints promptly and give the exact facts which will help us to locate and remove the trouble. Also kindly inform us if you see anything wrong with our lines or apparatus, even if the service is not yet affected; it will save trouble and annoyance later and will be appreciated.

If you will carry out the spirit of the above instructions, we will endeavor to do our part that, between the two, you will enjoy the best Farmer Line Service in the United States; which means, of course, the best in the world today.
