Telephone Attachments

Telephone attachments are being peddled in a miscellaneous manner throughout the country and are purchased by unsuspecting or unthinking users and attached to their instruments. Generally the so-called "helps," disinfectants, etc., are a positive hindrance to telephone service, not being so designed as to secure the maximum of efficiency in hearing or speaking.

Many of them get the lines and instruments into trouble, whereupon the Company, to protect its service, is obliged to remove them. Rubber earpiece attachments do not augment the sounds received, and often make it impossible to hang the telephone properly upon the switch-hook. Essentially the same result can be obtained by closing one ear with the palm of the hand. The instruments should be kept clean by wiping them.

Telephone instruments, necessarily very sensitive and intricate, have been designed to produce the best results as they are. In the interest of good service, subscribers are recommended to make no attachments of any kind to their instruments.

REGULATIONS WITH WHICH SUBSCRIBERS HAVE AGREED TO COMPLY

USE AND CARE OF EQUIPMENT. The subscriber shall not make, permit, or use any electric or mechanical connections, or apparatus with the lines, or equipment furnished by the Company, without the Company's consent. The lines and equipment on subscriber's premises shall be carefully protected, and used for lawful purposes where installed, and upon the termination of his right of use subscriber agrees to surrender them to the Company unimpaired, or to insure, indemnify and pay the Company for any loss or injury to them arising from carelessness, accident or any other cause. At all reasonable times the Company shall have the right, which the subscriber shall provide, of access from the street line, and of entering the premises of the subscriber to install, inspect or repair the lines or equipment, or to remove them upon the termination of the subscriber's right of use. The subscriber shall not use or permit the use of foul, abusive or profane language, or practice any other conductual with fraudious or malicious intent, over the equipment furnished.

EXCHANGE SERVICE. Subscribers to Exchange System service may, on the terms of their contracts, transmit local messages to all exchange telephones located within the limits of the exchange system in which the subscriber is served.

A local message is a communication not exceeding five minutes duration between subscribers' stations within the same exchange limits.

Flat rate business service is furnished only for the use of subscribers and their employees in their business.

Flat rate residence service is furnished only for the use of subscribers (and their families) at their residence.

THE COMPANY DOES NOT GUARANTEE UNINTERRUPTED WORKING OF THE LINES OR EQUIPMENT. For any complete failure of service of which notice in writing has been sent to the Company's general office, and continued for more than twenty-four hours thereafter, an adjustment of the contract charge for the period of such interruption shall be made.

The Company shall not be liable for defaults occurring on the lines of any other Company.

SUBSCRIBER'S NUMBER. The prefix and number assigned to a subscriber's station are no part of the contract with the Company and may be changed by the Company when necessary.

DIRECTORIES. The Company assumes no liability for damages arising from errors or omissions in the making up, or printing of the directory. Subscribers are requested, when they desire any change in their insertion to notify the Company in writing.

PRIVATE BRANCH EXCHANGE OPERATION. Operators employed by the subscriber for the operation of private branch exchange switching apparatus shall comply with the operating rules of the Telephone Company, and render service satisfactory to it.

COLLECTIONS. Statements for services are due upon receipt of bills rendered about the first of each month. Payment should always be made before the 15th of the month at the Local Exchange Office. Checks should be made payable to the Chicago Telephone Company. Subscribers are urged to settle their accounts promptly before they become delinquent to avoid suspension of service and inconvenience to their patrons and other users.

ALTERATIONS. The subscriber agrees to notify the Company promptly in writing whenever alterations or new construction on premises owned or leased by him will necessitate changes in the Company's equipment and the subscriber agrees to pay the Company's current charges for such changes. Estimates furnished on application.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR LOCATION. The Company will move the equipment to any point where the Company furnishes similar service, within the limits of the same exchange system accessible with its facilities, upon written order, when the subscriber agrees to pay the Company's current charges therefor. Such removal will be made without charge if service without change in line, equipment, or class of service has been continuous at one address or in the same name, for one or more years, but such removal without charge will constitute an express revision of the subscriber's contract for a period of one year from the completion of the removal. **AFTER A REMOVAL THE SUBSCRIBER SHALL PAY THE CURRENT RATE FOR SERVICE AT THE LOCATION TO WHICH THE REMOVAL IS MADE.**

TERMINATION. The subscriber or the Company may terminate the contract on current terms of liquidated damages applying to his class of equipment and service at any time before the equipment has been in use one year at one address or location and may terminate after such year by giving ten days' written notice, in which case the subscriber shall pay in full to the end of such ten days and the Company will refund the portion of any payment made in advance accrued at the end of such ten days.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS TO TELEPHONE USERS

TELEPHONE NUMBERS. Each subscriber's telephone is designated by a number placed at the left of his name. It is imperative they subscribers call by number (not name) to avoid error and always refer to the current telephone directory to obtain the correct numbers.

THE INFORMATION OPERATOR WILL FURNISH or **names NUMBERS** of new subscribers **NOT LISTED** and who have had service installed after this directory was printed, or of numbers which have been changed.

HOW TO USE THE TELEPHONE. A local message is a communication not exceeding the minutes' duration between subscriber's stations within the same exchange area. To tell the Exchange Office, take the hand telephone from the hook and place it to your ear. If the telephone has a crank, after it has run two seconds, lift and give the quick turns of the crank before removing the hand telephone from the hook. The operator will say "Number, please?" Give the exchange name and number of the subscriber wanted, and the operator will repeat them to avoid errors. Return it to the telephone at the ear and no answer is received. If the desired line is busy, the busy signal can be repeated having reason the operator will notify you of that fact. This means that the line called is忙 in use. Always hang up the hand telephone when through talking and if the telephone has a crank attachment, give two quick turns of the crank to notify the operator to disconnect.

HOW TO ANSWER A TELEPHONE CALL. Remove the hand telephone from the hook and give your name number, as for example, "This is Main 231" (or whatever the number may be). This will immediately inform the person calling that the desired subscriber has been connected.

REPORT TROUBLE. When the line or instrument is out of order, notify the Manager or Chief Operator of your Exchange. If the trouble is not recorded within two working hours, notify and action to writing to General Manager, Chicago Telephone Co., 220 W. Washington St., Chicago, Illinois.

A TOLL MESSAGE is a communication to a telephone beyond the limits of your local exchange system, but within the area in which the Company operates. A Long Distance Message is a communication to a telephone outside of the area in which the Company operates. The Company's employees never are authorized to transmit or deliver verbal or written messages to patrons.

Toll or Long Distance rates are for messages of three minutes or less. A charge is made for each additional minute or fraction thereof.

TO MAKE A TOLL OR LONG DISTANCE CALL. Call for "Long Distance" and when the Long Distance Operator answers, give the name of the town, and exchange name and number, when known, and the name and address, or the necessary information to identify the party desired. The operator will make the connection and will call you to the telephone.

TO MAKE COLLECT CALLS. Toll or Long Distance calling, even to most "small," provided the person receiving a collect message agrees to allow the same to be charged to him. Request to have the charges made against the party called for should be made at the time the call is given to the Toll or Long Distance Operator.

ORDER TO MOVE TELEPHONE. If you wish to have telephone moved, please **FILL OUT** a move order and send to **MANAGER** of your Exchange, at No. 220 W. Washington St., Chicago, at least ten days before date required, as desired.

NOTE. Thirty days' notice is necessary for removal between April 1st and May 1st.

Toll Service

Believing that our toll service adequately meets the demand for quick communication between telephone users in the various cities and villages near Chicago, we encourage our patrons to use the long distance lines.

If the desired line is busy the busy signal (an interrupted buzzing sound) or the operator will notify you of that fact. This means that the line called for is in use. Always hang up the hand telephone when through talking and if the telephone has a crank attachment, give two quick turns of the crank to notify the operator to disconnect.

HOW TO ANSWER A TELEPHONE CALL. Remove the hand telephone from the hook and give your own number, as for example, "This is Main 284" (or whatever the number may be). This will immediately inform the person calling that the desired connection has been established.

REPORT TROUBLE. When the line or instrument is out of order, notify the Manager or Chief Operator of your Exchange. If the trouble is not remedied within twenty-four hours, kindly send notice in writing to Control Manager, Chicago Telephone Co., 220 W. Washington St., Chicago, Illinois.




